

# HERTFORDSHIRE CUBS RECORDS

## FOOTBALL GOAL CHALLENGE

### Equipment :

2 x 8ft x 4ft Goals

4 Footballs

Stopwatch

(Tape Measure, Line Marking Paint)

### Record Attempt:

The 2 Goals are placed on a line 5 metres apart.

A shooting area is marked 14-16metres away from the goal line.

The balls are stored in a box 20metres from the goal line. The ball must be dribbled one at a time to the shooting area

Each Cub has the use of 4 footballs, and has a maximum of 2 minutes to complete the record attempt.

Cub Scouts must attempt to score 4 goals. Goals **MUST** be scored in alternate goals. The time is started from the moment the first ball is kicked, and ends when the 4<sup>th</sup> ball crosses the "goal line", or stops short of the goal line.

The record will be the highest number of goals scored. If more than one Cub scores the same number of goals, then the fastest time is the record.

Any goal scored that was not kicked from within the shooting area does **NOT** count.
