Go straight over 4 roundabouts staying on the Dual Carriageway. After 4<sup>th</sup> roundabout road turns to single carriageway. Turn left at next roundabout, and left at next roundabout into Gresley Way. Follow instructions below</p> <p><u>From A10 - (Ware/Hertford)</u> Take the A602 towards Stevenage. As you come into Stevenage, Turn right at the 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout, then left at next roundabout into Gresley Way. Follow instructions below</p> <p><u>Once in Gresley Way, Stevenage.</u> Take 2<sup>nd</sup> left into Magpie Crescent, and follow the road round, turning right into and parking in Sainsbury's Car Park. The District HQ is in between the Doctors Surgery and Community Centre to the left of Sainsburys'</p>
