Go straight over 4 roundabouts staying on the Dual Carriageway. After 4th roundabout road turns to single carriageway. Turn left at next roundabout, and left at next roundabout into Gresley Way. Follow instructions below</p> <p><u>From A10 - (Ware/Hertford)</u> Take the A602 towards Stevenage. As you come into Stevenage, Turn right at the 2nd roundabout, then left at next roundabout into Gresley Way. Follow instructions below</p> <p><u>Once in Gresley Way, Stevenage.</u> Take 2nd left into Magpie Crescent, and follow the road round, turning right into and parking in Sainsbury's Car Park. The District HQ is in between the Doctors Surgery and Community Centre to the left of Sainsburys'</p>

11:30 → 12:30	<i>Science Badge Practical</i>	A chance to make and experiment with some of the following items which are used within the 3 year programme; Lava Lamp, Periscope, Rain Gauge, Volcano, Anemeter.

13:00 → 14:30	<i>International – Linked to Module 19 learning objectives.</i>	An information burst about how international themes can be brought into your pack night, camp or sleepovers.
