Go straight over 4 roundabouts staying on the Dual Carriageway. After 4th roundabout road turns to single carriageway. Turn left at next roundabout, and left at next roundabout into Gresley Way. Follow instructions below</p> <p><u>From A10 - (Ware/Hertford)</u> Take the A602 towards Stevenage. As you come into Stevenage, Turn right at the 2nd roundabout, then left at next roundabout into Gresley Way. Follow instructions below</p> <p><u>Once in Gresley Way, Stevenage.</u> Take 2nd left into Magpie Crescent, and follow the road round, turning right into and parking in Sainsbury's Car Park. The District HQ is in between the Doctors Surgery and Community Centre to the left of Sainsburys'</p>

14:00 → 14:45	Role of Sixers and Seconders in a Cub Pack	Find out some useful hints and techniques about how you can ensure the Sixers and Seconders understand and carry out their responsibilities within your pack to ensure it benefits both themselves and your leaders.
15:00 → 16:00	"Special" Needs	Every child has different needs within your Pack. This is a chance to find out about the different groups of needs your Cubs may have, and how to deal with them.
